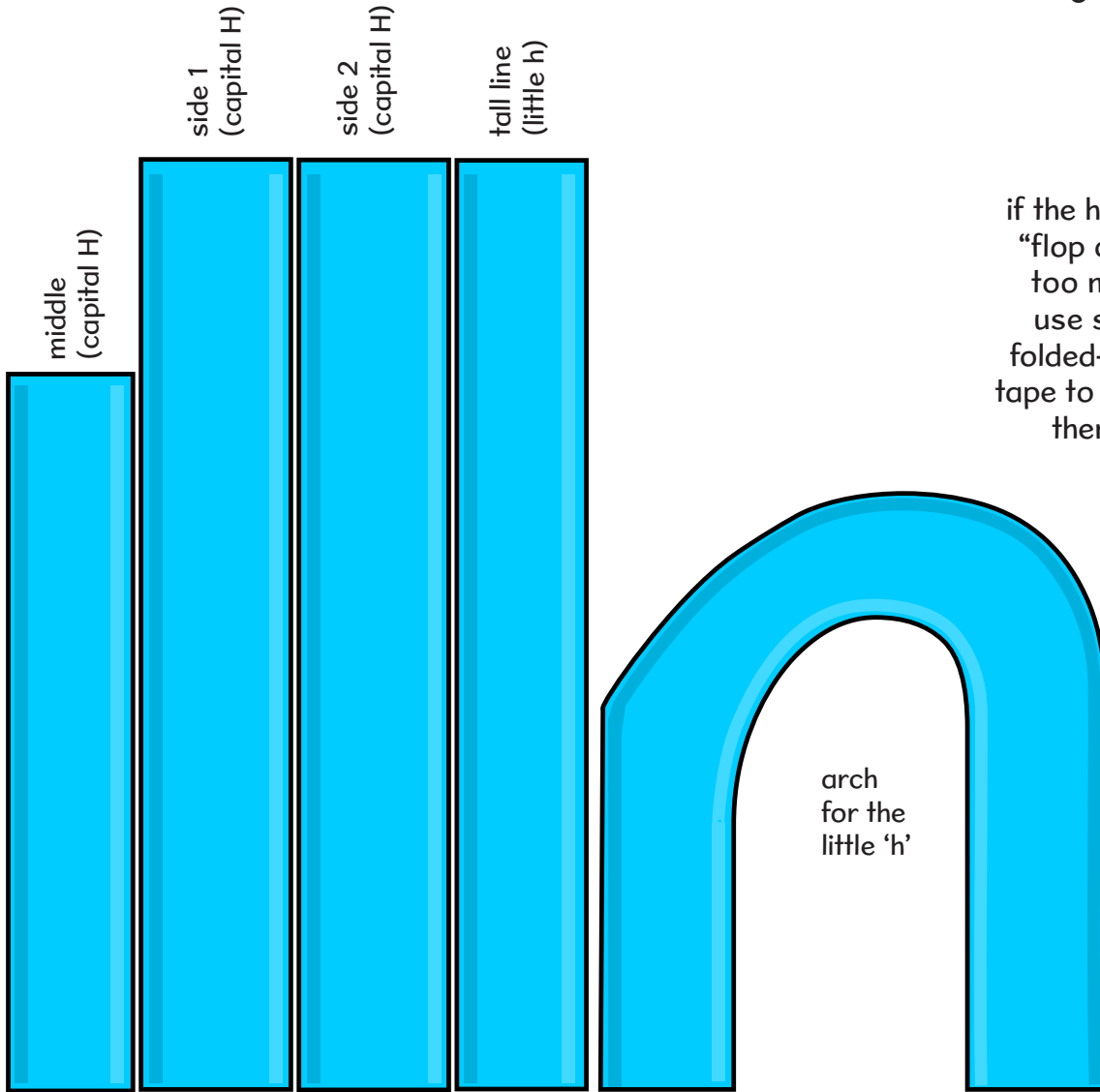
Once the “eyes” are glued on, use a pen or Sharpie to draw some surprised (raised) eyebrows.



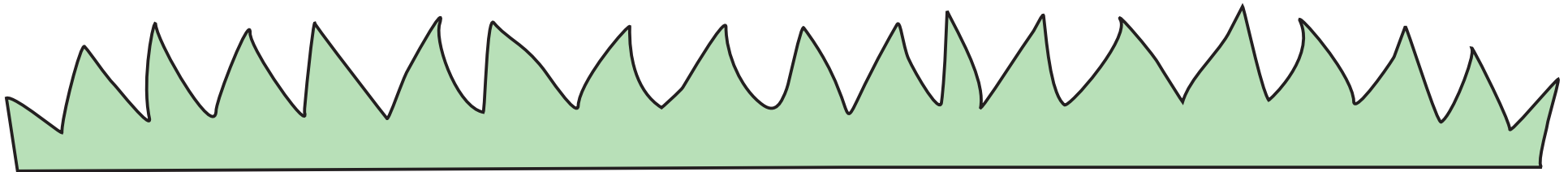
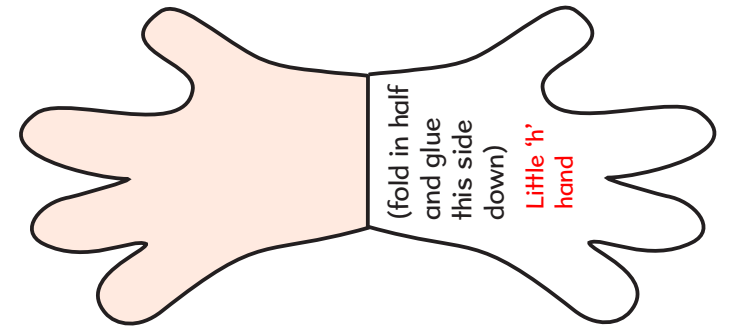
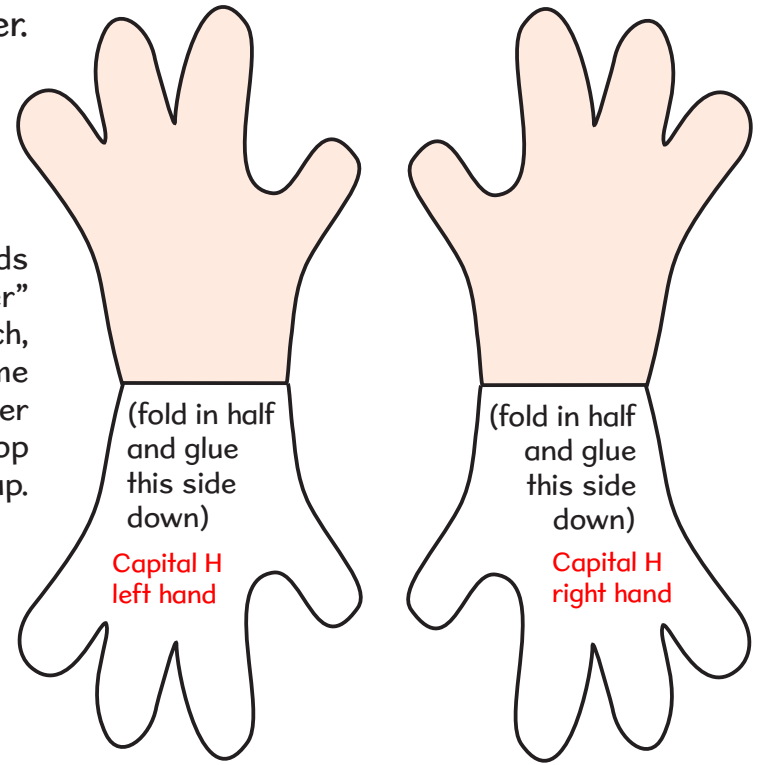

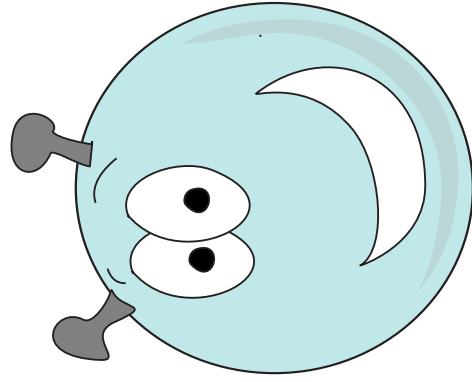
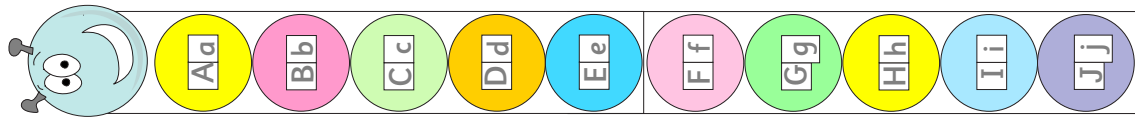
To make the "tentacles," cut out the colored strips and, one by one, run them along the edge of a table or the blunt edge of scissors to curl them, then tape to the jellyfish.

The finished project should look something like this.

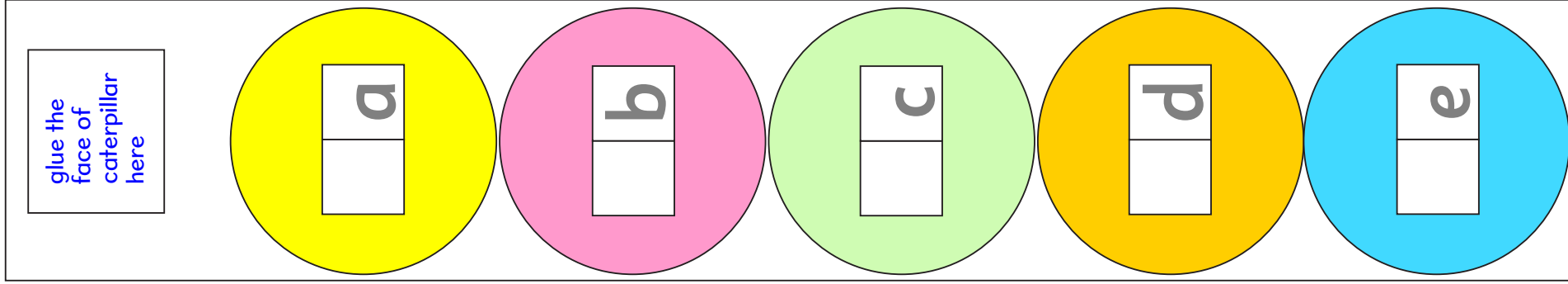


Cut out the caterpillar's head and glue/tape it to the top of strip #1.
