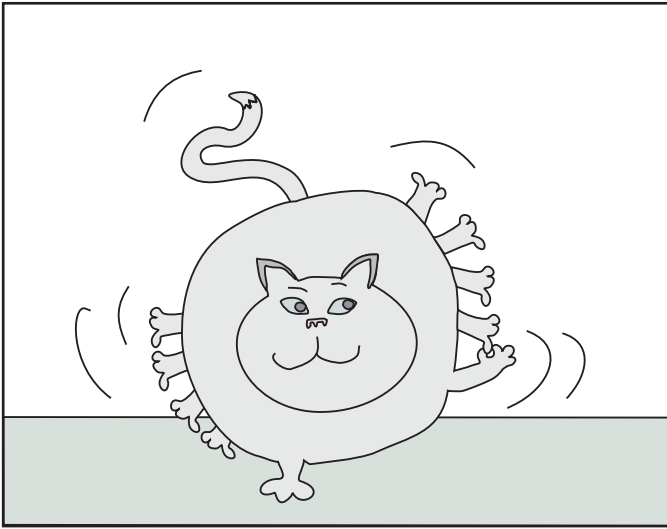

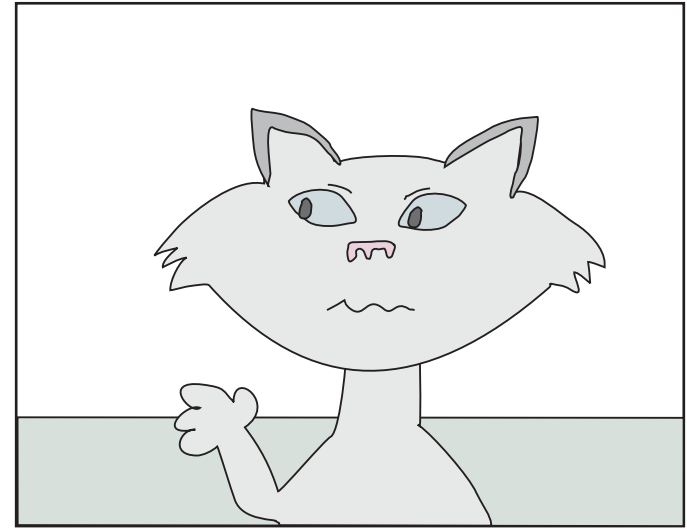

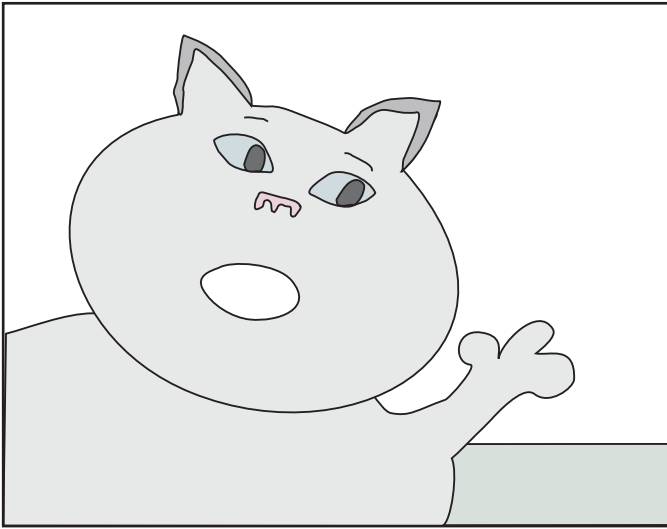


"Silly **cat**," says **tim**.
if it were **fun**

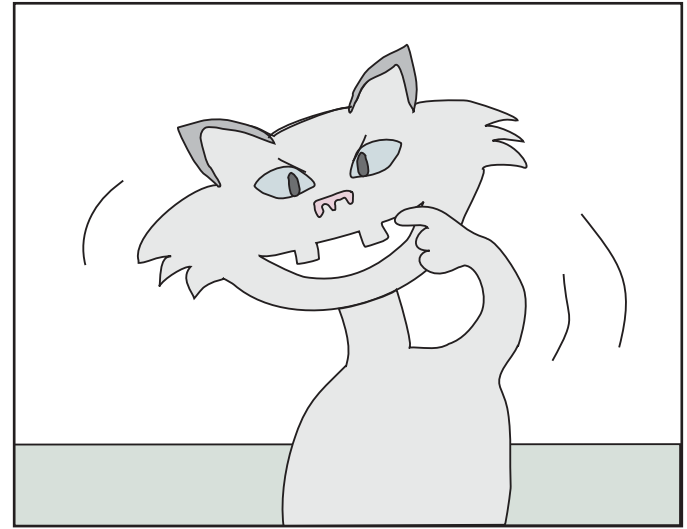
counting feet, how come

fun.”

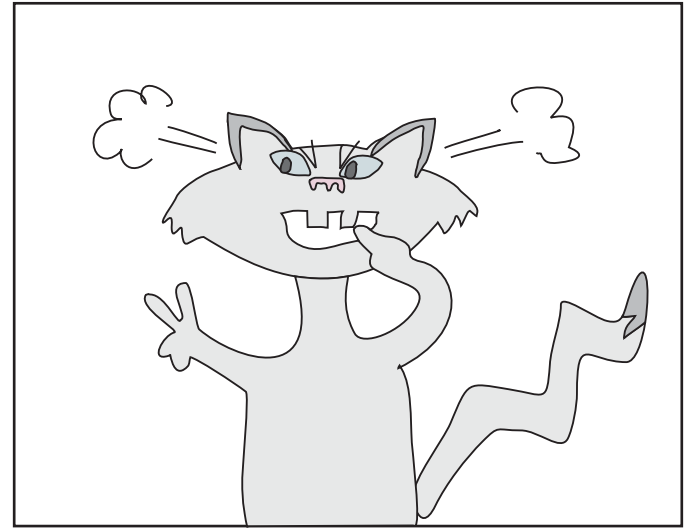


"One tooth?" says **tom**.

had two teeth."

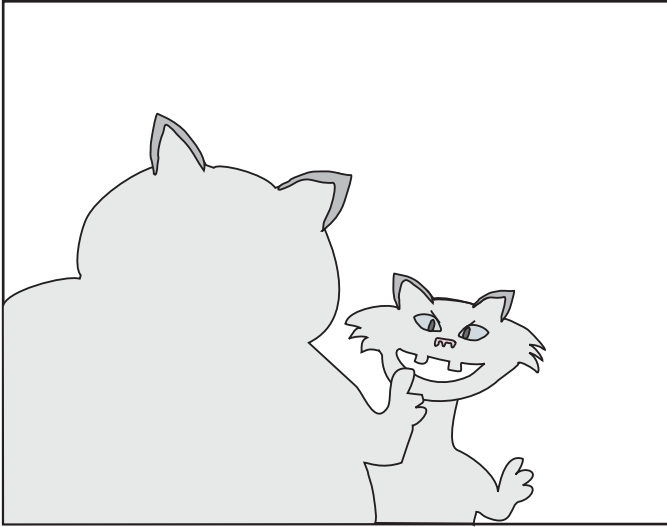


I said 'one, two,' not,

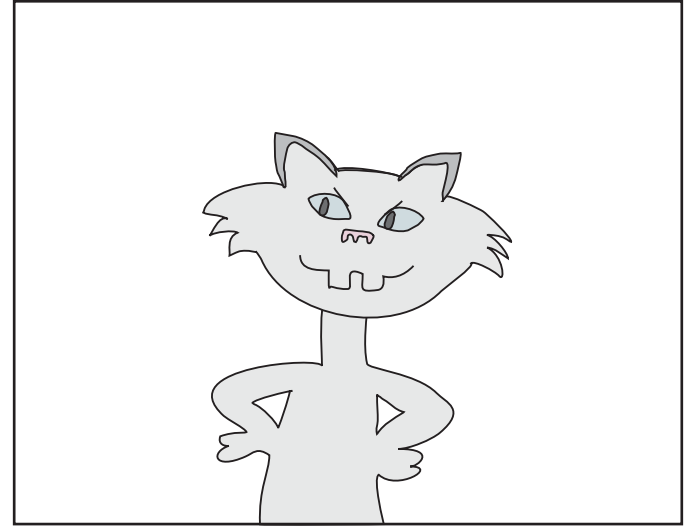
'one tooth.'" says **tim**.

"See? You **can** count

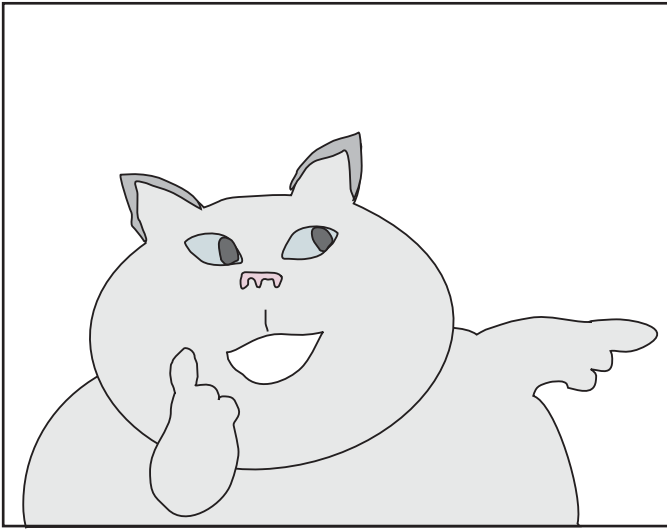
them yourself."



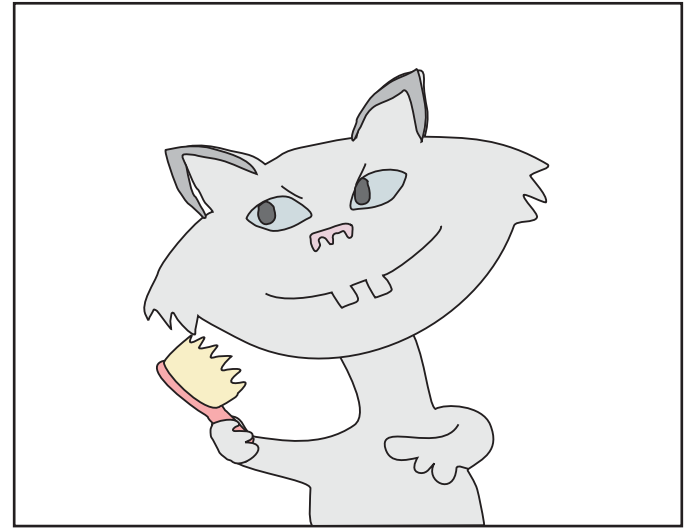

teeth."



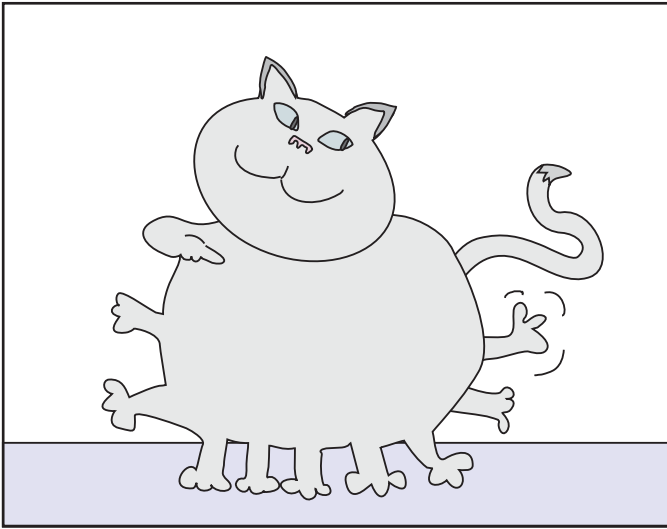
"I told you so," says

my feet. Okay?”



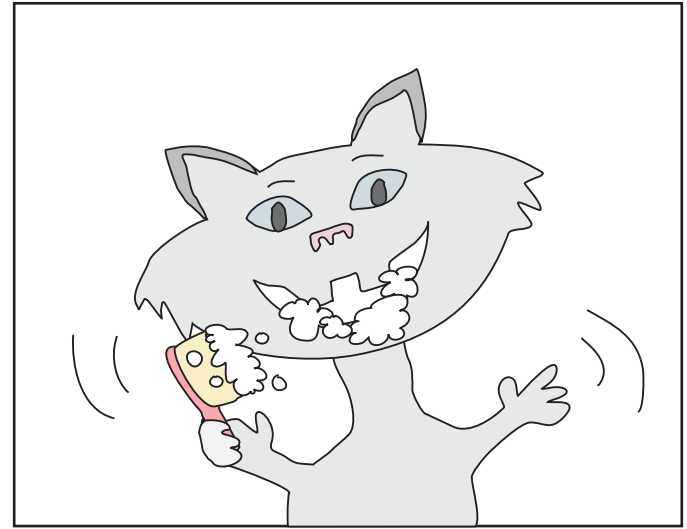
“**I am** ready,” says
