
This is the letter "r." The letter "r" says "-rrr-" like in rain, rabbit, ring, rocket and rhinoceros.



The letter "r" looks a lot like the letter "f," except that it is shorter and doesn't have a stick across the middle.




We can make the letter "r" with one hand.



And what does the letter "r" say? (Have the child make the letter "r" sound several times.)


There is one word in this book that uses the letter "r." Can you read it?








"Then wear a pair of my running shoes," says tom.

tim puts on the



are too big."











"Slow down!" says tim.

"I did not say you were fat. I said you


were going too fast...

stamping one or two of his feet. "I am not sickly. I am healthy - biq and healthy."




"You need your ears checked," says tim.

hearing."




"Earrings?" says tom.

because I am not



"Aaaaaaah!" says tim.


