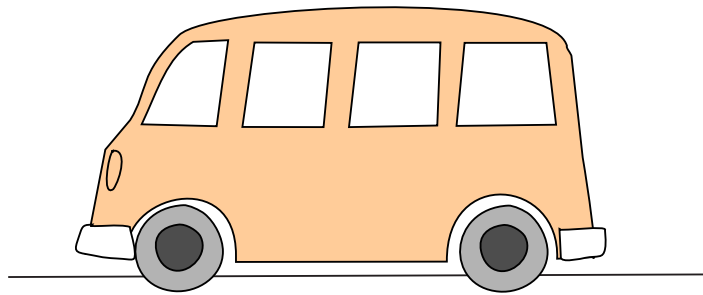

Letters learned in the first series:

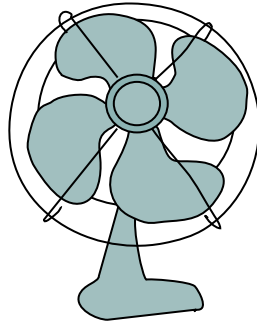

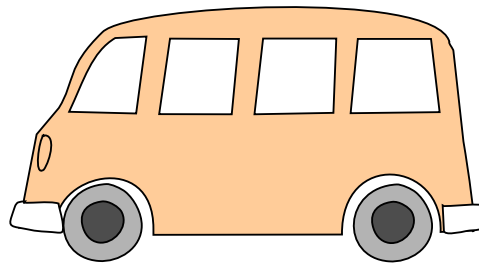

sound a lot like each other.

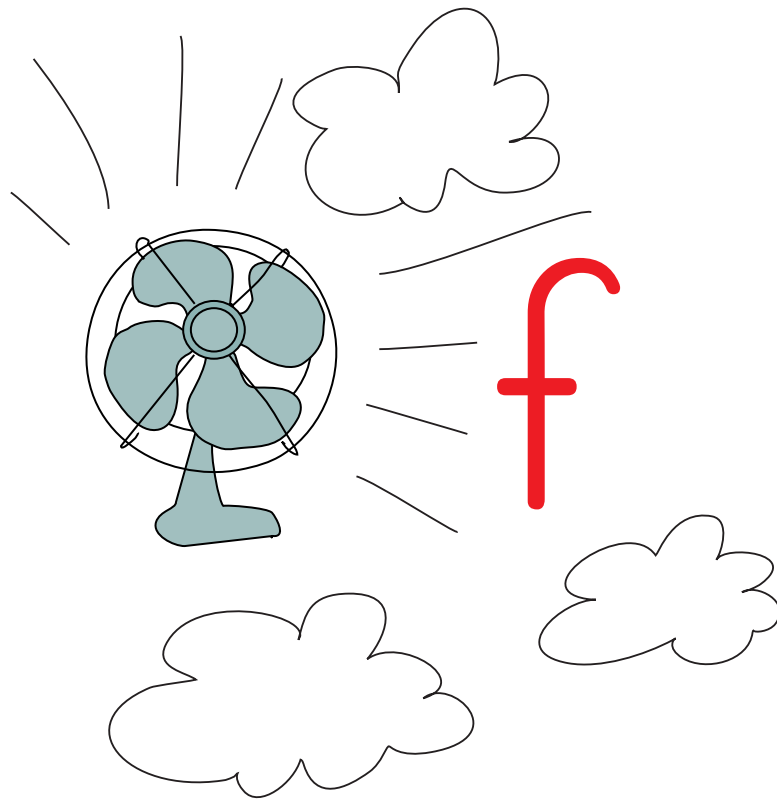

van

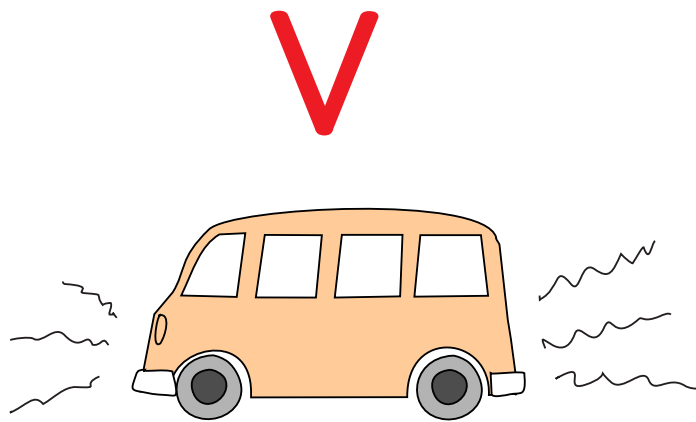


The difference is that you're just blowing air when you make the letter "f" sound - "ffffff." No sound from your throat, just air. Think of a fan blowing air.



(Have the child put their hand in front of their mouth to feel the air blowing.)

But when you make the letter
“v” sound, you **ARE** making
a sound in your throat, sort
of like the engine (motor) in
a van.

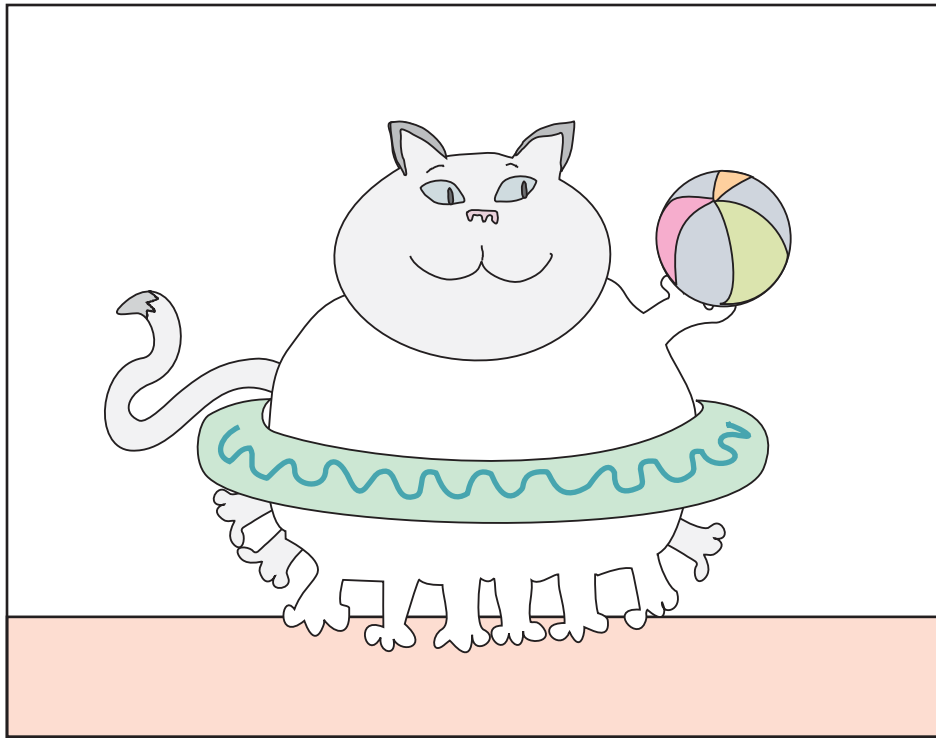


Have the child put their hand
on their throat to feel the sound
(vibration) in their throat.

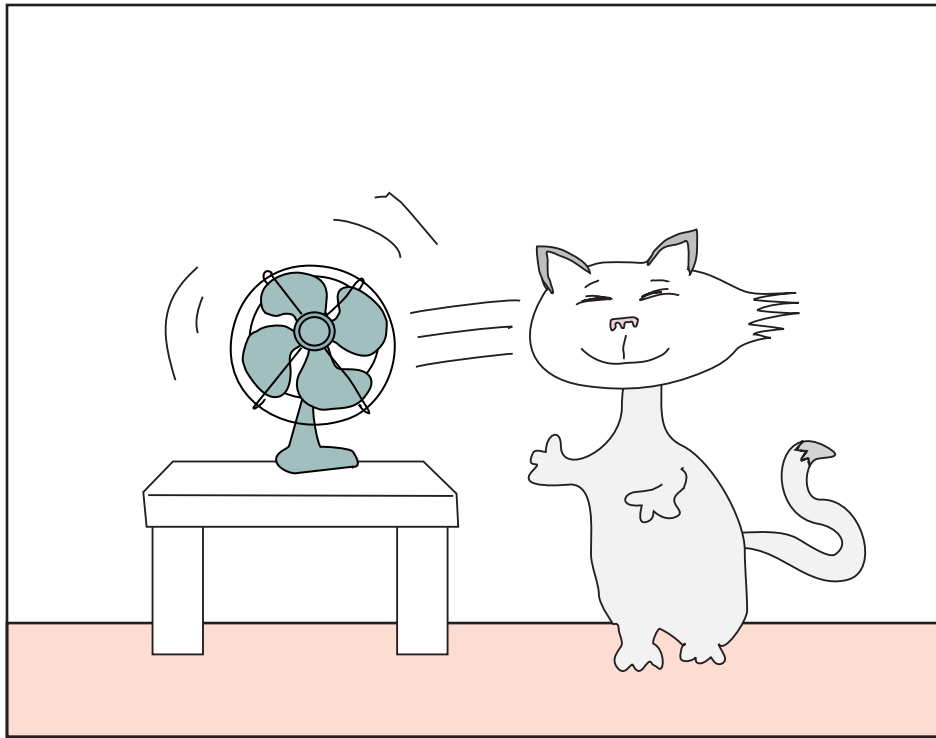
In this book, we will be reading

fan

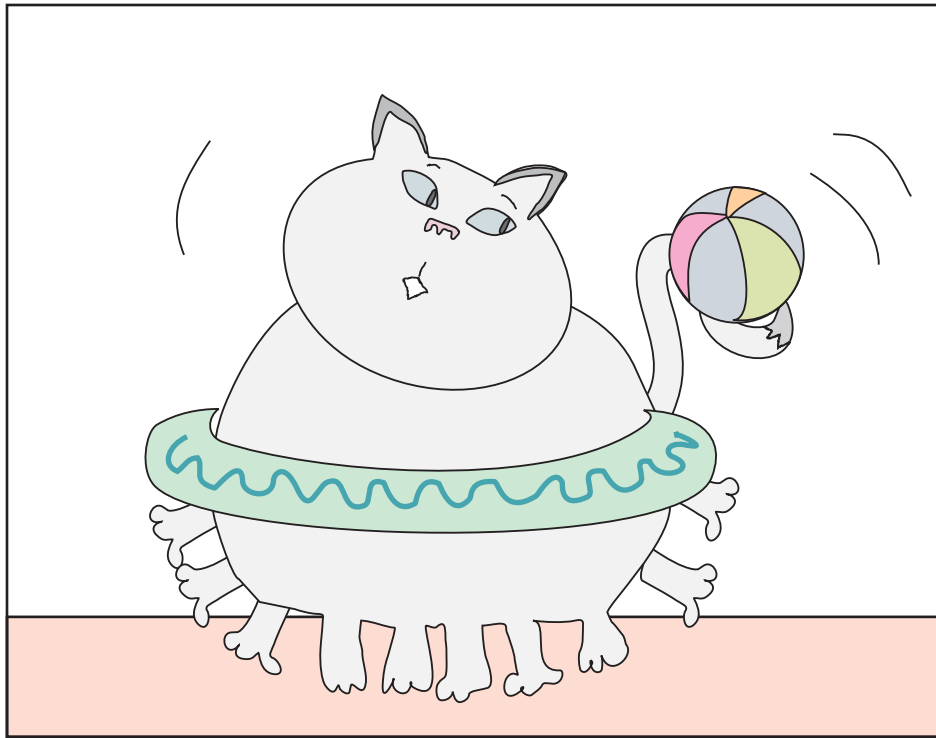

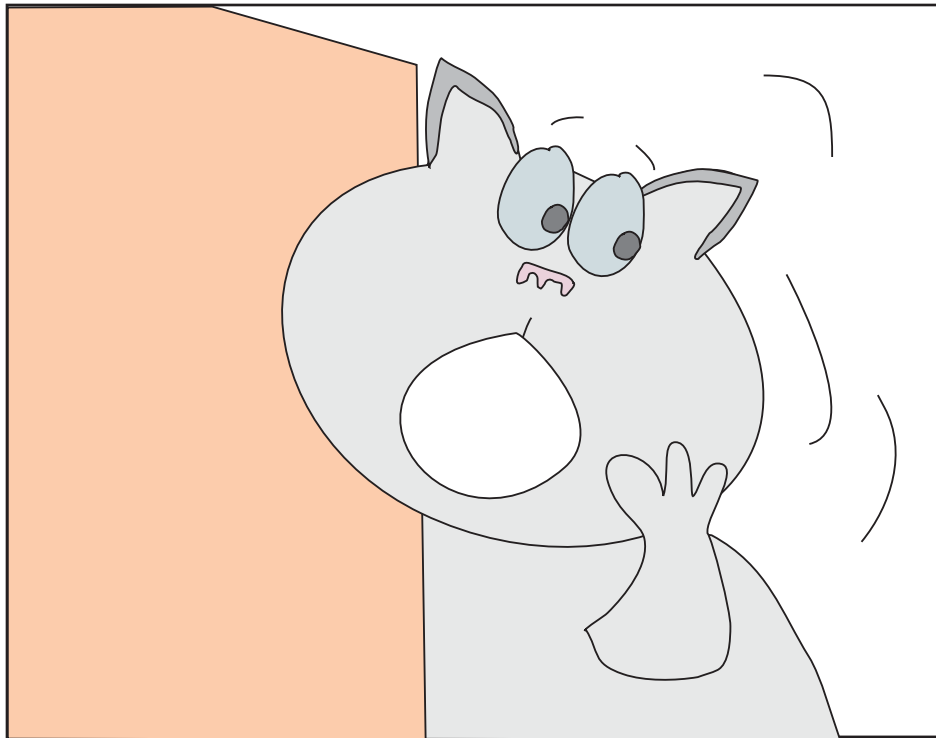
“it is hot,” says

and cool.”



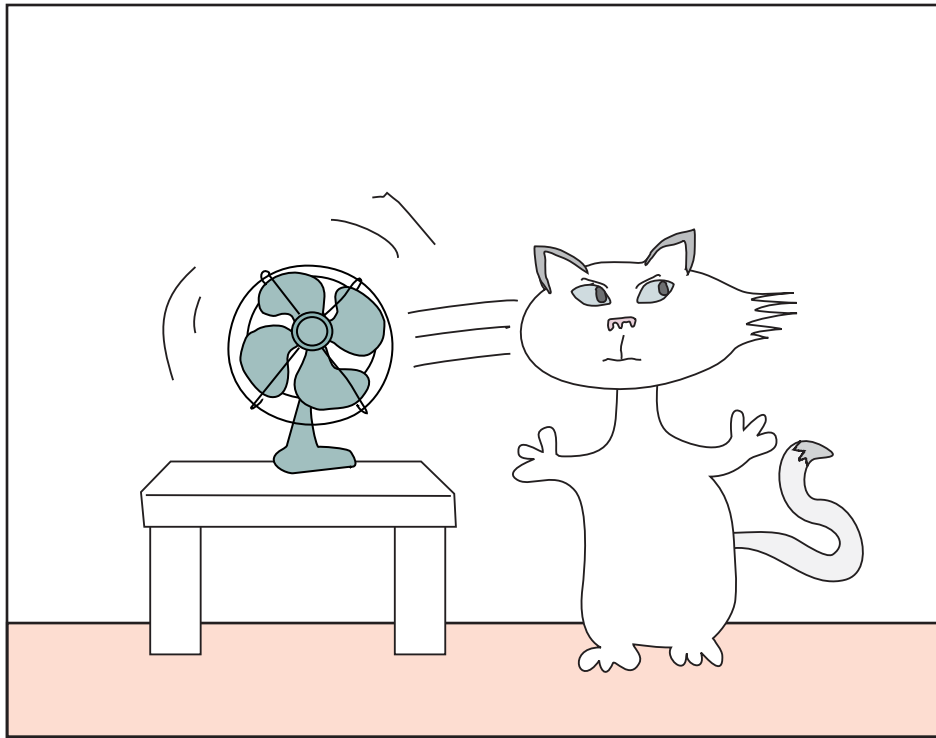
“Well, **I** like water,” says

sit by me and the

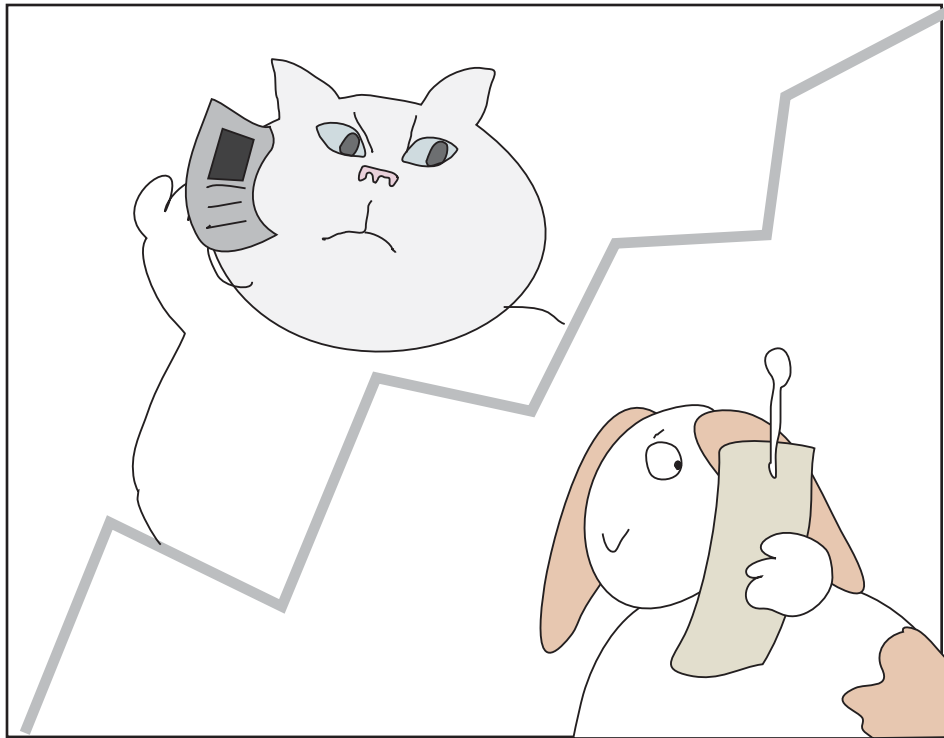
fan.”

cop.”

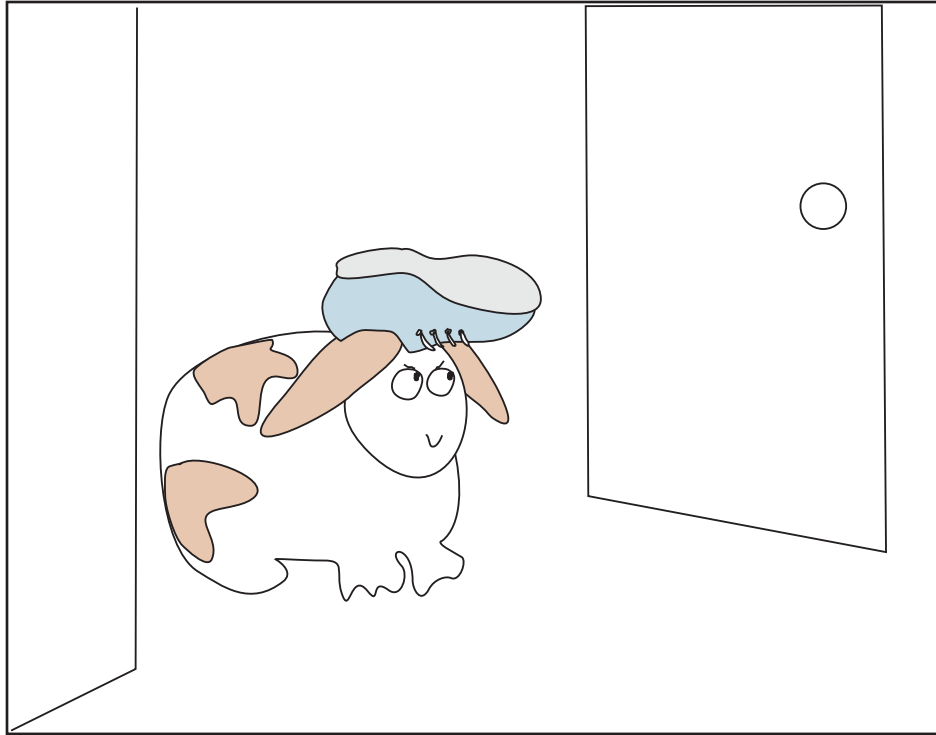


“Hellooooooo?” says the

ten minutes.”

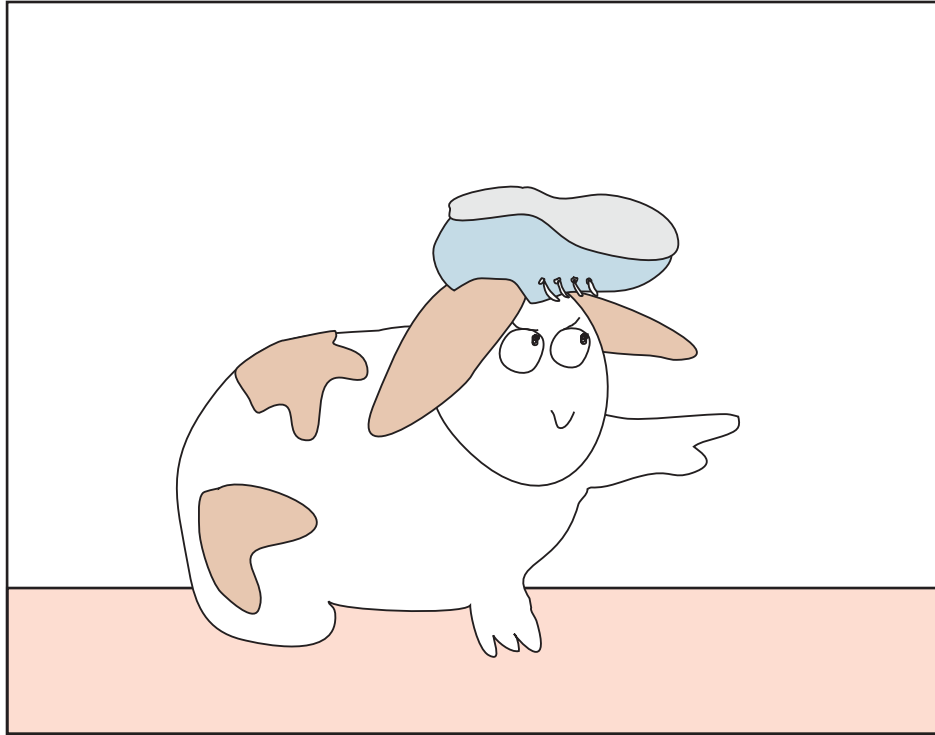


When the rabbit arrives,

tom shakes his head.

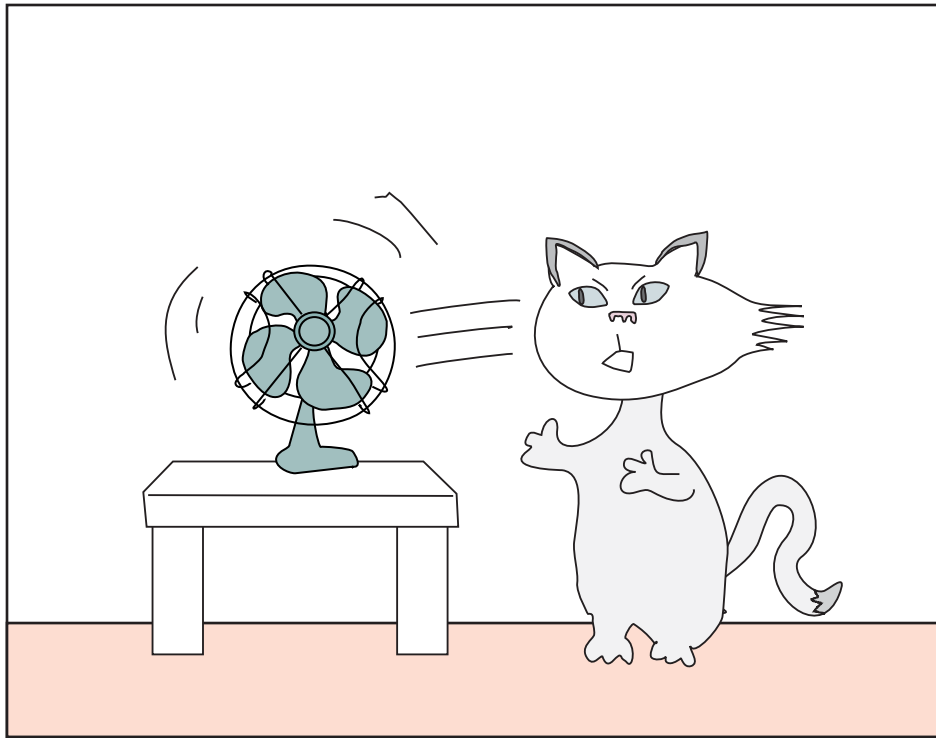
“if I could show you

be missing.”



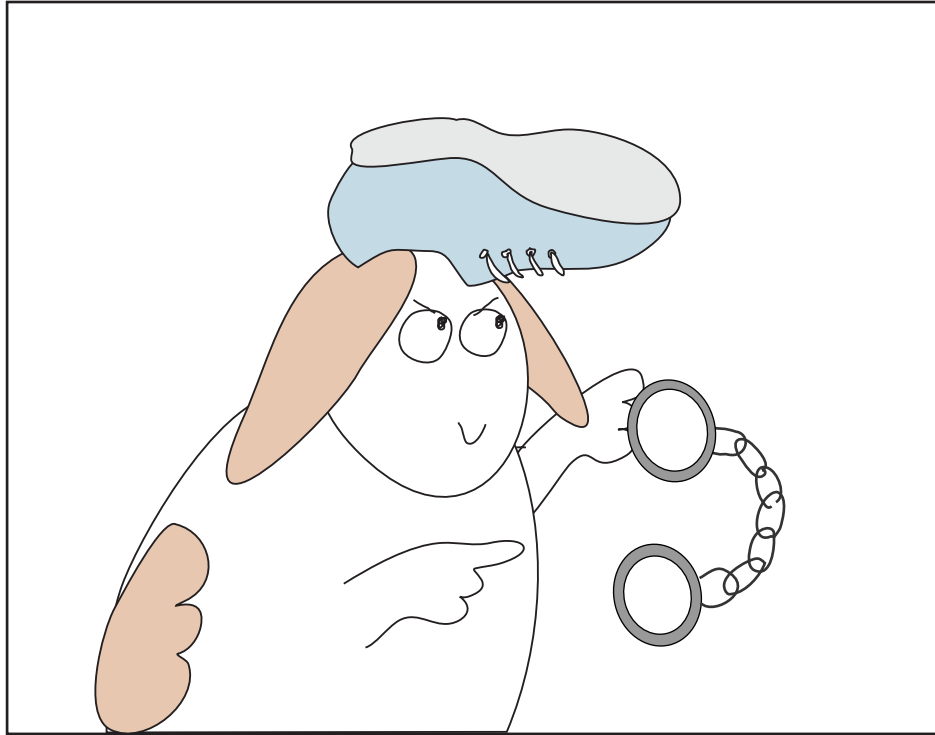
“There!” says the rabbit.

“f--f--f--fan.”



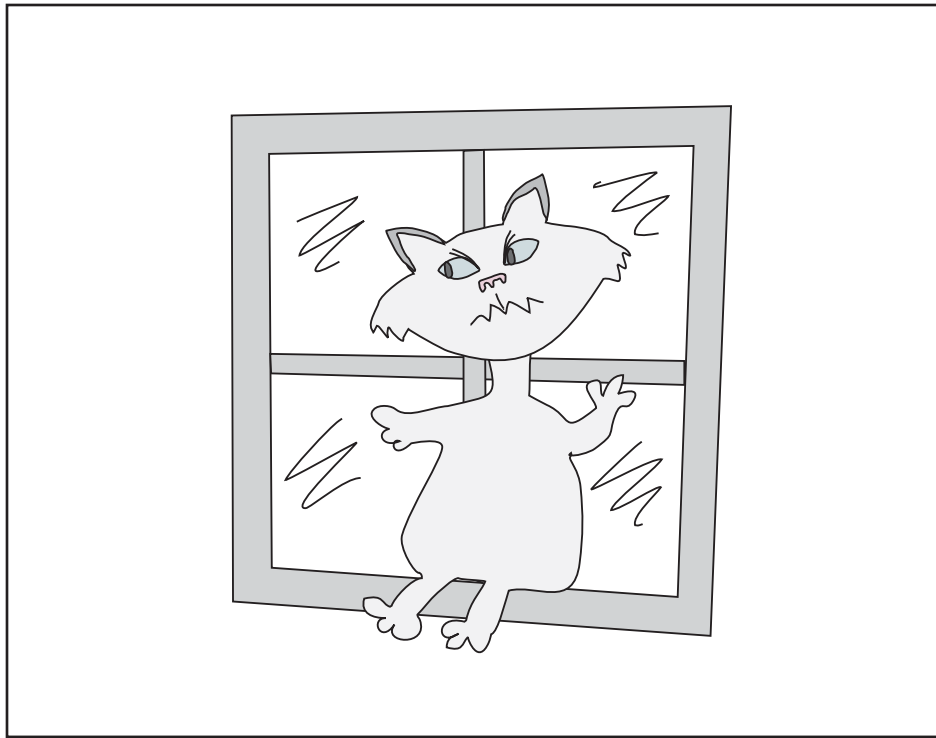
“fan, van, no

have to take you to jail.”

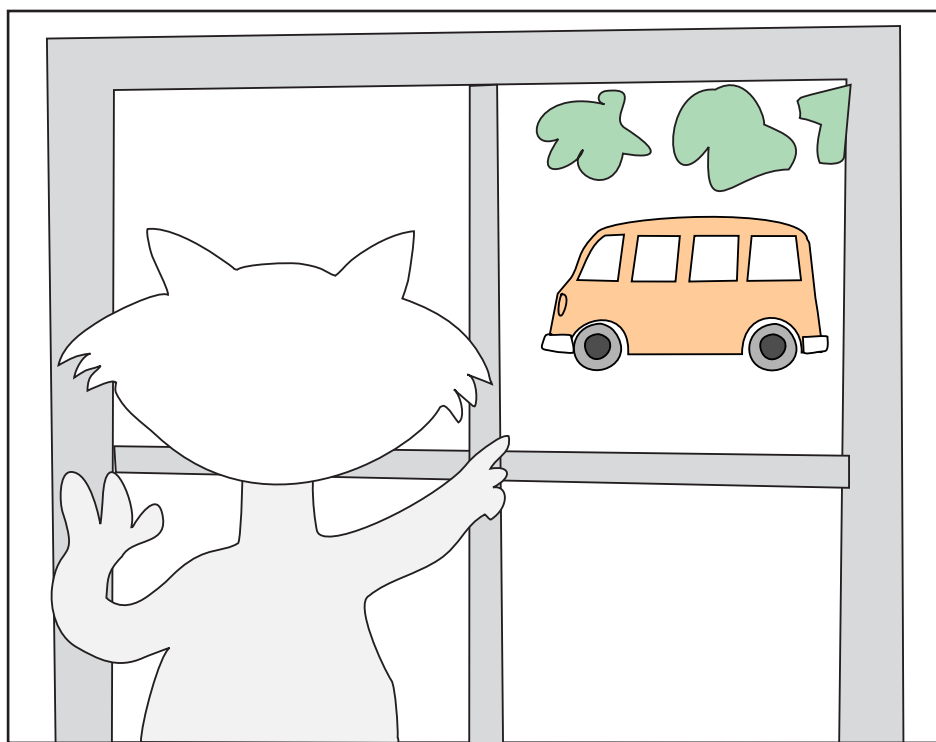


tim jumps up on

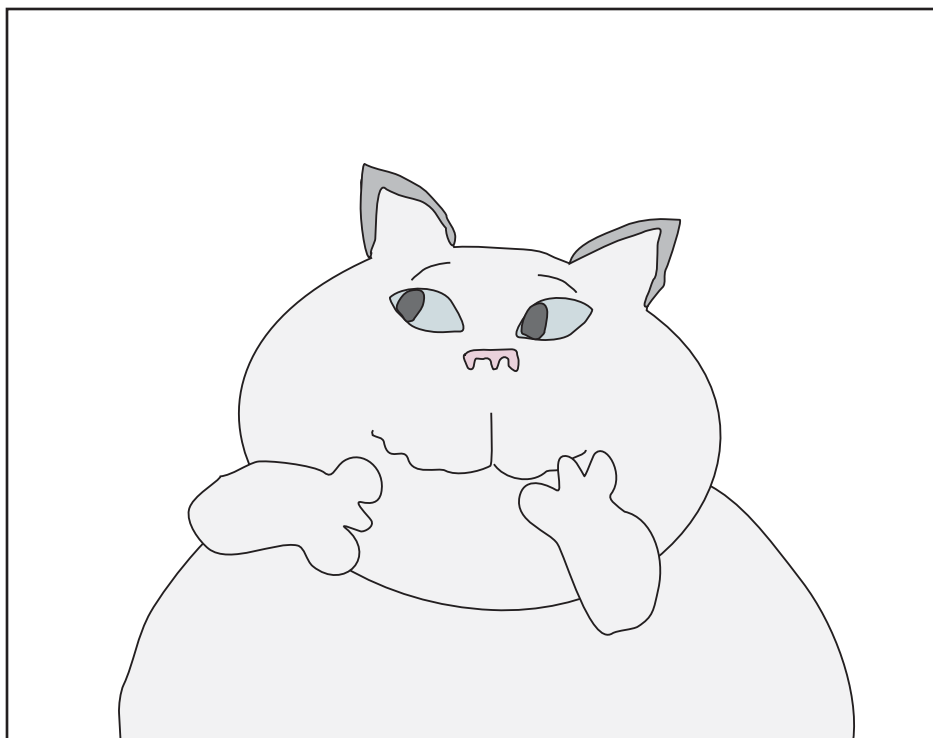
the window sill. "get

“Oh, yeah,” says **t**om

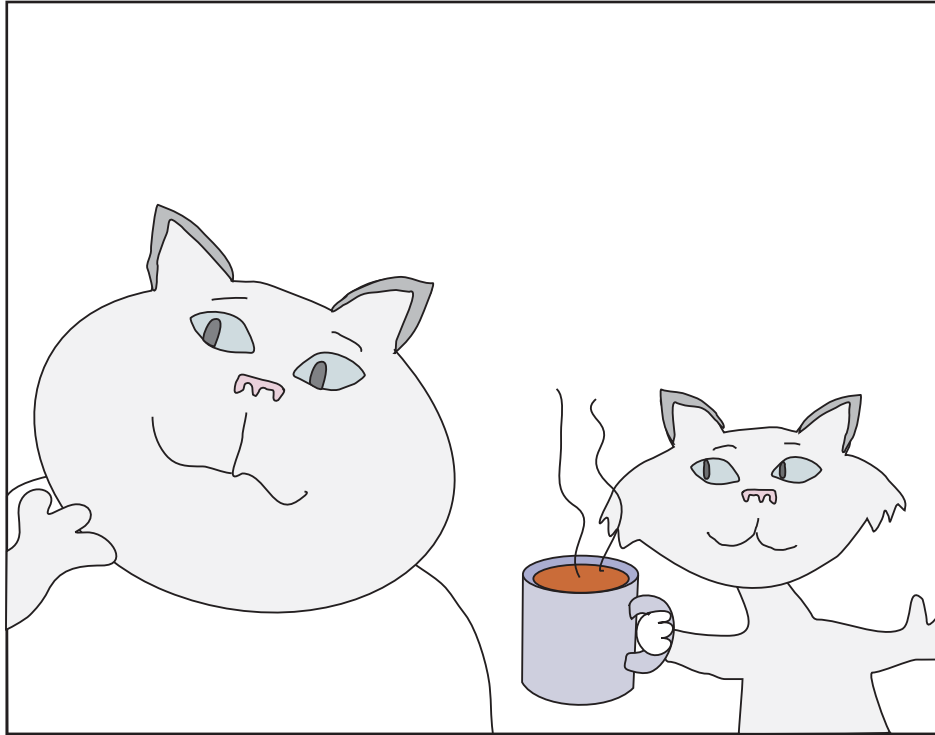
“**I** forgot. **I** parked
