

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#### **Quick Start Guide**



Read the book WITH your child. You read the "regular" text, and he/she reads the big, red words, sort of like reading the different parts in a play.

Help your child sound out the words as needed.





Read the book several times. This helps develop the eye muscles and left-to-right reading patterns that are necessary for reading.

Don't rush it. Bodybuilders don't train in a day – neither does a child.





If your child is having difficulty, he/she may need more practice with the alphabet. Get some fun books about the alphabet, and read them many times. Then come back to Progressive Phonics.

And most important of all, HAVE FUN!



These words were identified by Edward William Dolch, PhD., in 1948; the theory is that children who can read these words rapidly and without conscious effort will be well on their way to becoming good readers. The "Dolch List" is the backbone of many English reading programs, including Progressive Phonics.

#### (This picture has 5 differences.)




They took US to the zoo.

moose **got** loose and drank the **jug** of juice, so now Jack juggles with no **jug**, no juice, no moose.


### Mug Ugh!


I left some milk in a big, blue mug, and then I left the mug on the big, blue rug. A few days later, when I found the mug, I looked inside, and I said, "Ugh!"



and wipes his eyes...




He goes outside and big surprise...rub-a-dub-dub a cub in the mud.

In Part Two, we practice the reading of "book style" fonts (letters). Two of the biggest differences are the letters "a" and "g" —







#### Get Rid Of A Bug








And what if the bug
