To make the “noodles,” cut out the yellow strips and, one by one, run them along the edge of a table or the blunt edge of scissors to curl them, then tape to the bowl.



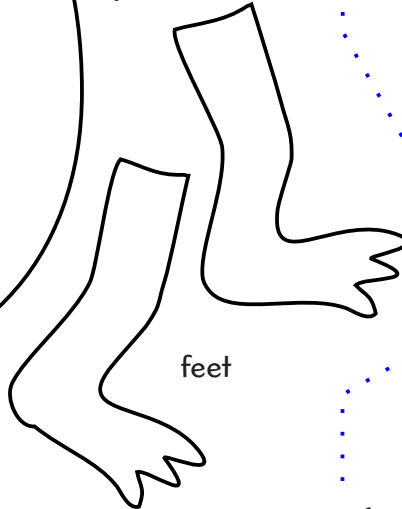
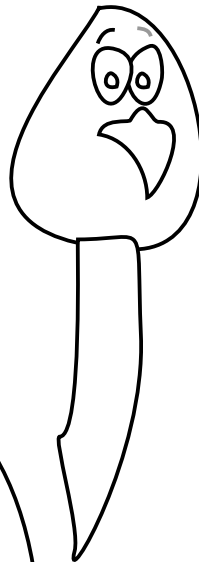
