Memory Game Instructions

Print <u>two</u> copies of the letter cards (next page).

Cut along the light-grey dotted lines, and then fold the cards in half so that the letters/question marks face outwards. If you want, you can also tape or glue the cards so that they lay totally flat, but this isn't absolutely necessary.

<u>To set up for the game</u>, shuffle the cards and lay them on the table or floor, letter-side down.

<u>To play</u>, First player turns over two cards. If they match (for example, Capital A and little 'a'), the player keeps the cards and turns over two more cards. If the next two cards do <u>not</u> match, the play goes to the next person.

Play until all pairs are matched up. The person with the most pairs wins.

Store the cards (a plastic baggie works well) for future games. As more sets of capital letters are added to the game, the game will become more difficult. Instead of playing with ALL the alphabet, you can play with only 10 or 15 pairs of letters to make the game easier or quicker to play.
