




Letters to be learned in this series:



This is the letter "s" — the letter "s" says, "Sssssssss," like in sun, sock, soap and six.




The letter "s" not only sounds like a snake — "Ssssss!" — it looks like a snake.

And let's see who can make the "ssssss" sound the longest!


Let's use our hands to make the letter "s" —





Sid talks to SiS all


day long. Sid talks about


And because **SIS** is a

toy mouse and cannot speak,



SIS comes flying out with a big pop, and sid isn't sad anymore.




