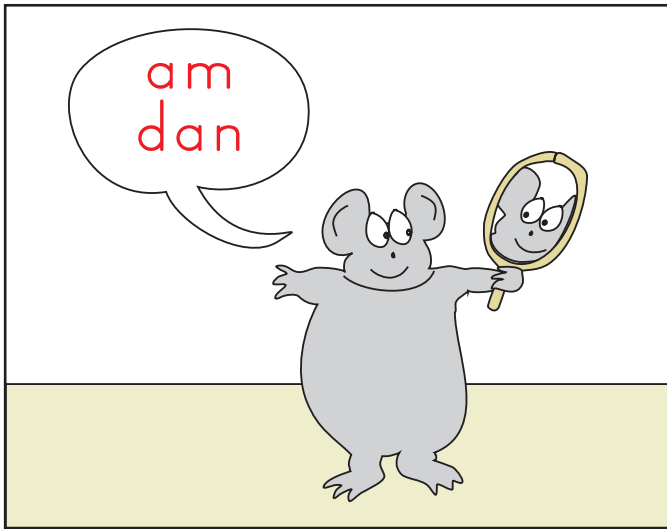


**sid** is not the only

see **sis**.

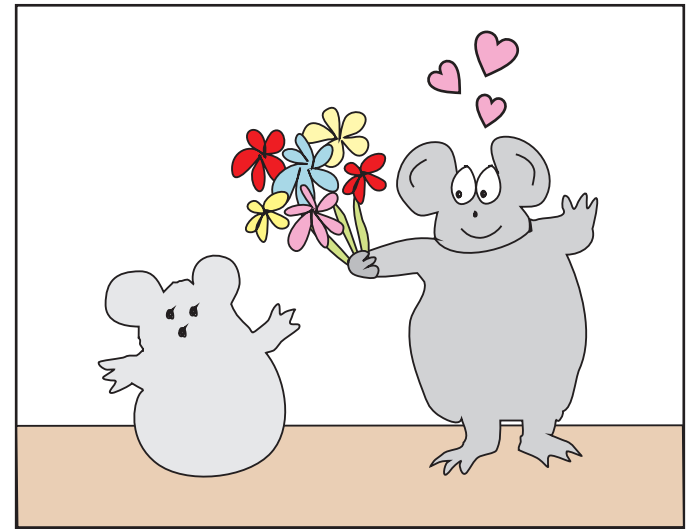


But no matter how much

very, very **sad**.

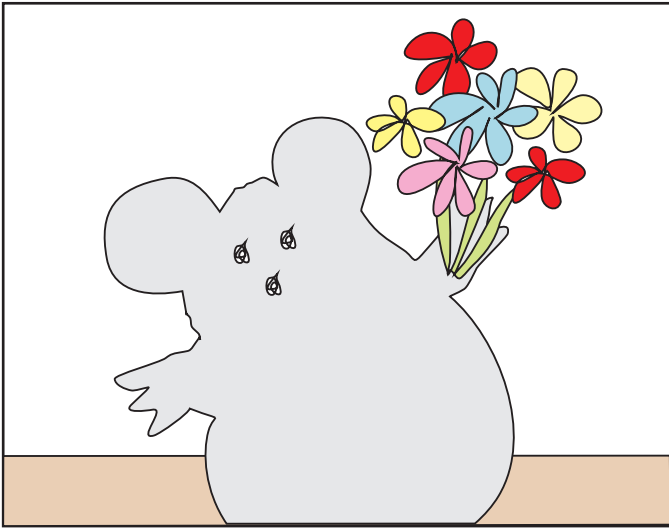


Finally, **dan** says to himself, "I **am** not a scared little mouse.

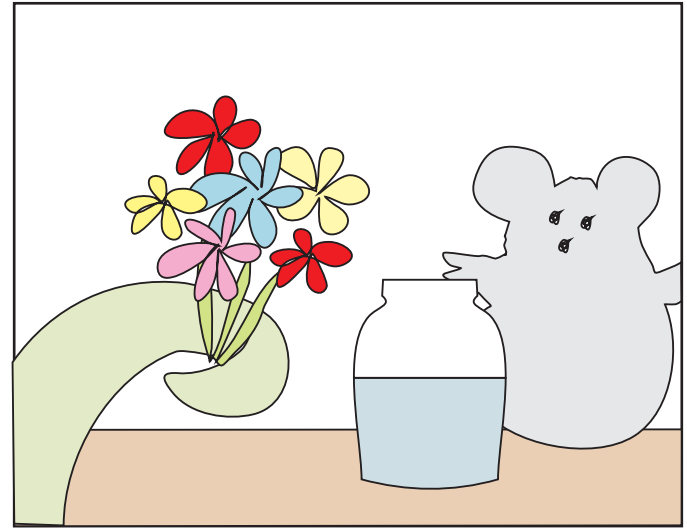
I **am dan**, and I **am** a **man**."



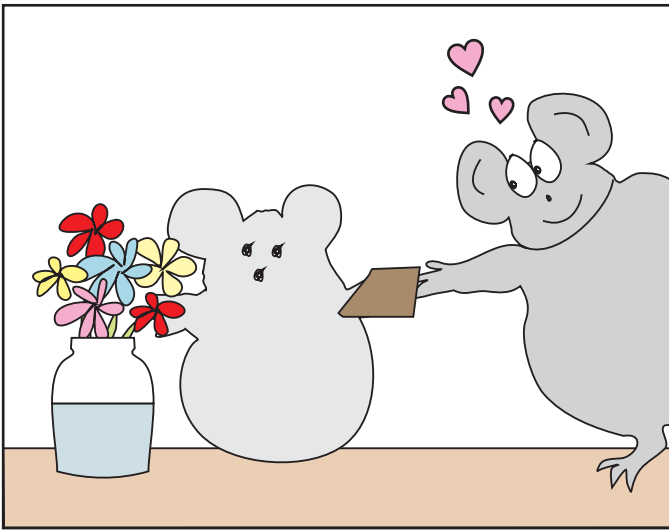
When **sid** takes his afternoon nap, **dan** climbs **in** the cage and gives **sis** a beautiful bunch of flowers.



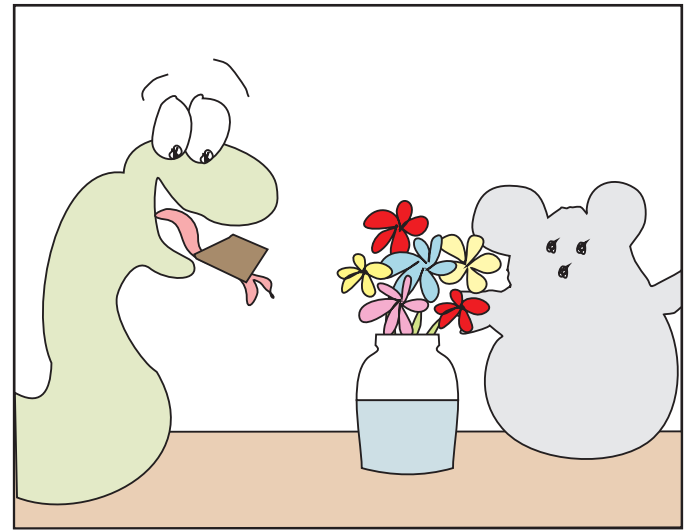
**sis** doesn't say anything,

doesn't even have a mouth!



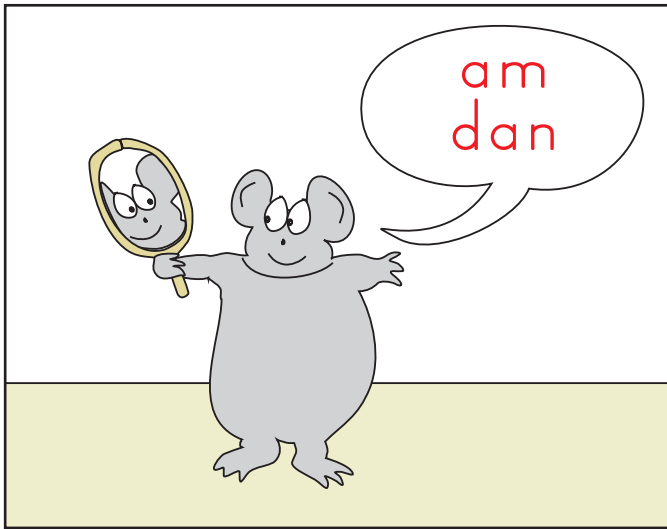
When **sid** wakes up from

flowers **in** a jar of water.



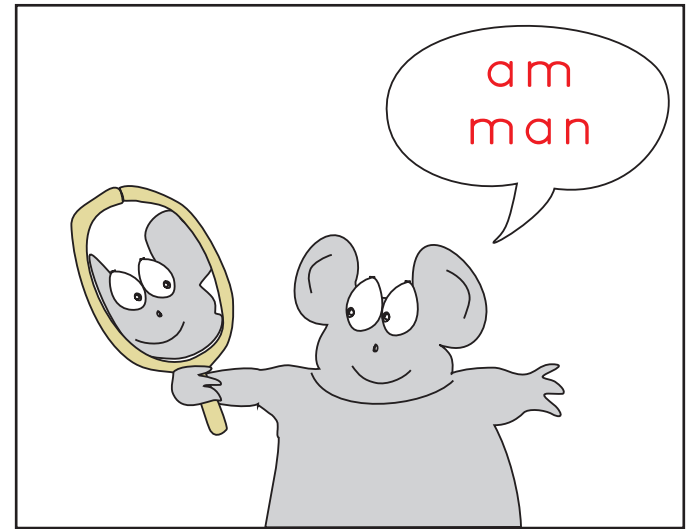
The next day, **dan** brings

nods her head just a little.



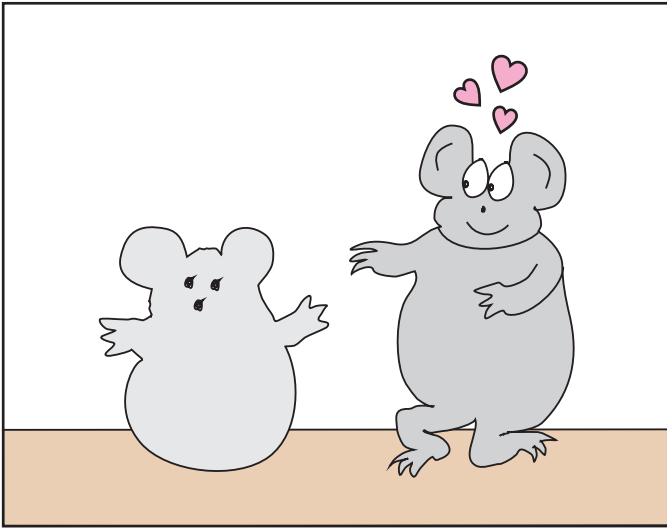
When **sid** wakes up from

sweet as this chocolate!"



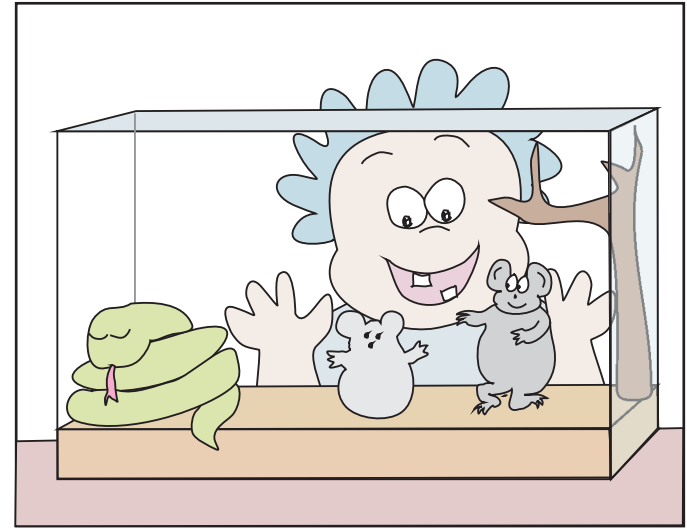
**dan** wants to ask **sis**

**dan**. I **am** a **man**."



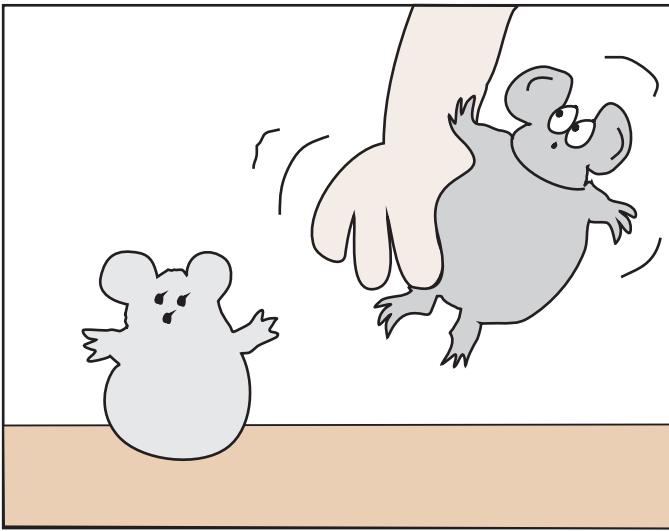
And to make sure that

and I **am** a **man**."



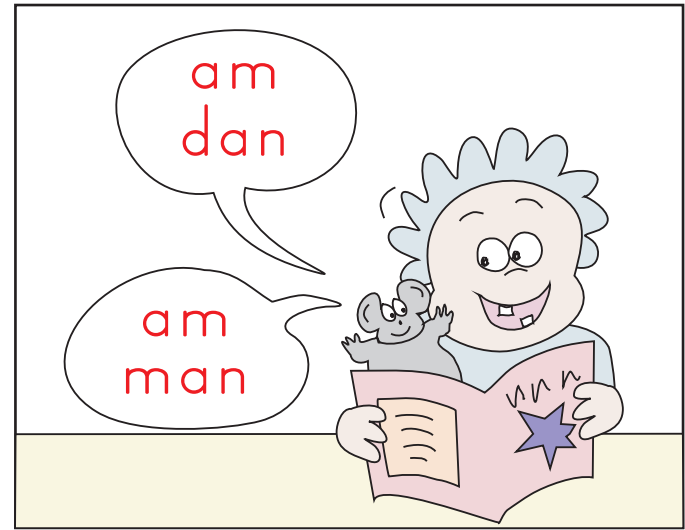
While **sid** takes his

he sees another mouse.

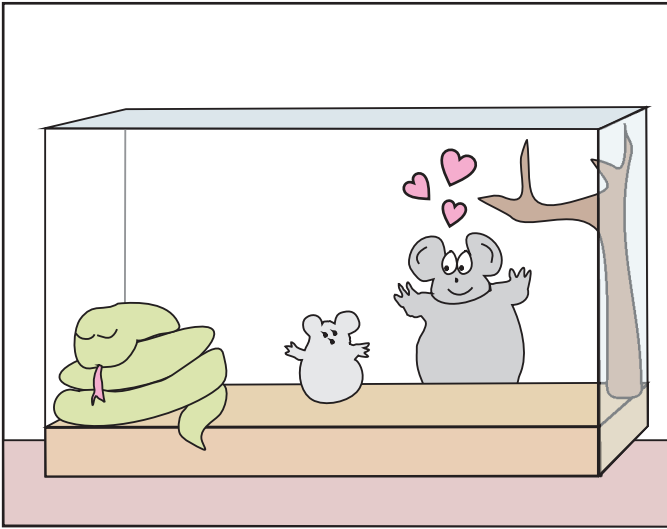


**sam** puts his hand

not listen.

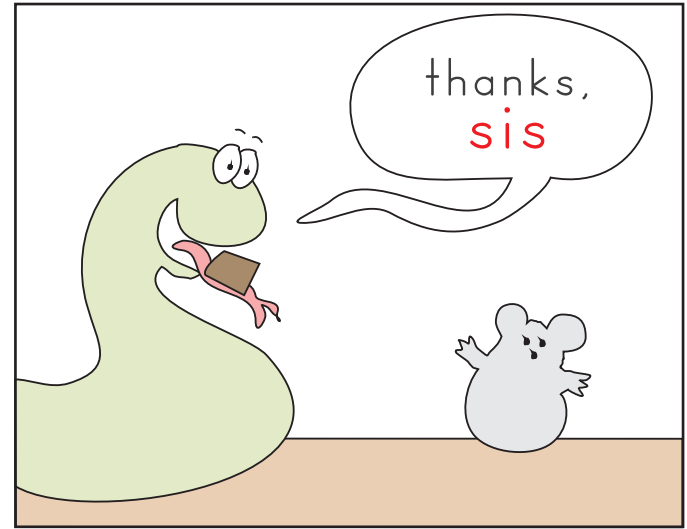


After a while, **sam** and
