
This is the letter "t." The letter "t" says "-t-" as in tiger, teeth, tent and turtle.



The letter "t" looks like a stick of spaghetti with another little stick lying sideways across it.




We need two hands to make the letter "t" with our hands:

There are three words in this book that use the letter "t" — can you read them?




tim and tom are

twins although they don't


look like twins.

feet. "Whatever shall


I do with all these feet?"




"Ballet!" says tim.

"Do I have to wear pink




tim, who is cooking

thinks for a minute and


says, "Ballet — you could

be a ballet dancer."




Tom pokes his tummy.


"Yes, I know my tummy is big, but what does belly dancing have to do with my feet?"




The next day, tim and tom go to a ballet class.

put ON his ballet shoes."




tom puts on a tutu and ten pink ballet shoes.




tom learns how to

to the music.




Next, tom learns how to do pirouettes. tom spins around and around in circles.




pop, pop, pop!

fly off his feet.




One shoe lands In a fish bowl.

tom to tim.


"I know," says tim.




Next, the teacher shows

de-chat, which means "step


of the cat."

This gets tom in quite a tangle.




After the class, tim

says tom.




"And they made my feet
