



We usually use the little "I" in the middle of a word.




And we use the big "I" when we talk about ourselves, like when we say, "I am me," or "I ate my lunch."





The big letter "I" looks a lot like the letter "t," except that the big letter "I" has TWO little sticks, while the letter "t" only has one stick.







The big letter "I" also looks a lot like the letter "L," except that the letter "L" doesn't have any sticks at the top or bottom.
