



The letter "f" and the letter "v" sound a lot like each other.


fan






The difference is that you're just blowing air when you make the letter "f" sound — "fffff."

No sound from your throat, just air. Think of a fan blowing air.



(Have the child put their hand in front of their mouth to feel the air blowing.)


But when you make the letter "v" sound, you ARE making a sound in your throat, sort of like the engine (motor) in a van.




Have the child put their hand on their throat to feel the sound (vibration) in their throat.

tom. "Let's drive the Van to the beach and swim in the water."




"I don't like water," says

tim. "And anyway, this


fan is keeping me nice

and cool."




"Well, I like water," says

Van is gone!"




"Don't worry," says tim.

sit by me and the fan."




"No way," says tom.


"A Van doesn't

drive off by itself.


I am calling a cop."

I can find it."




tom shakes his head.


"if I could show you

be missing."




- "There!" says the rabbit.

"f--f--fan."




"fan, van, no

difference," says the rabbit.


"Sorry, tim, you stole the fan van, so I

have to take you to jail."




tim jumps up on the window sill. "get away from me, you crazy rabbit!"

under the tree?"




"Oh, yeah," says tom
