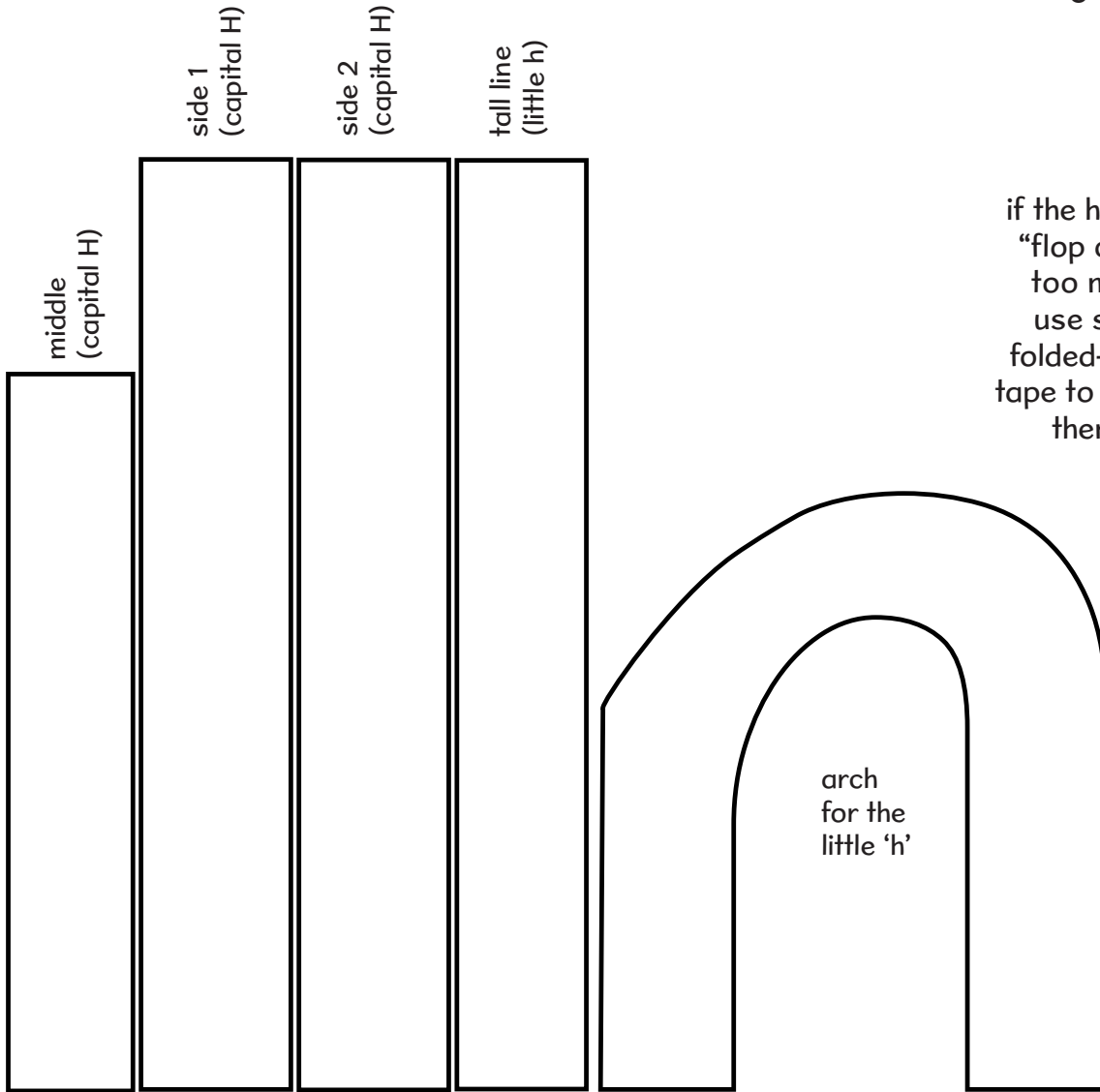
Once the "eyes" are glued on, use a pen or Sharpie to draw some surprised (raised) eyebrows.



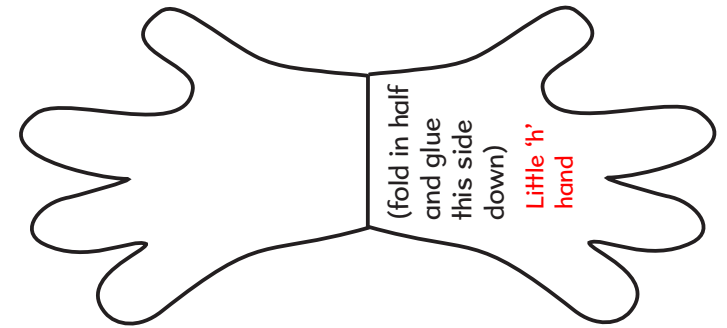
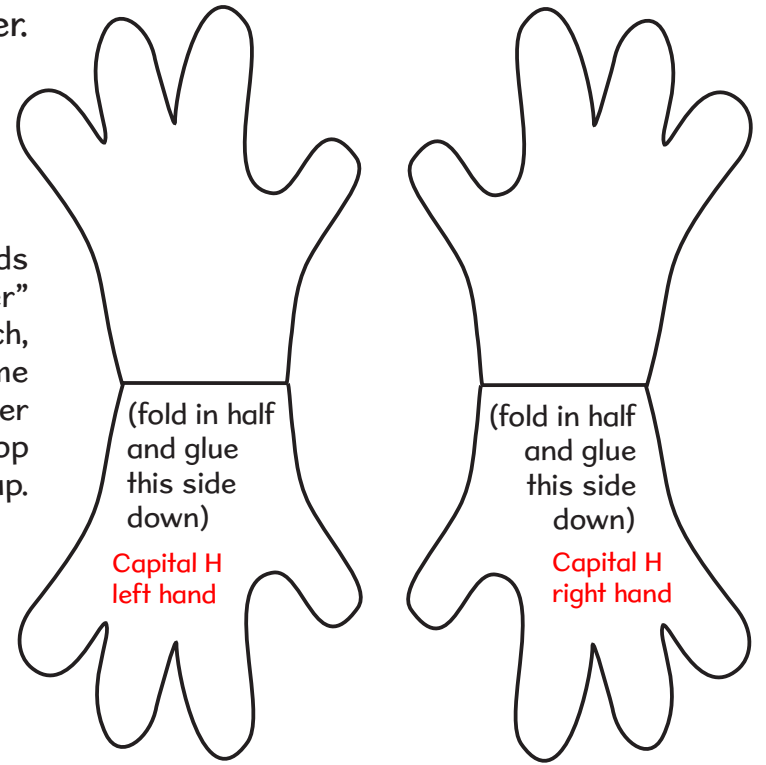

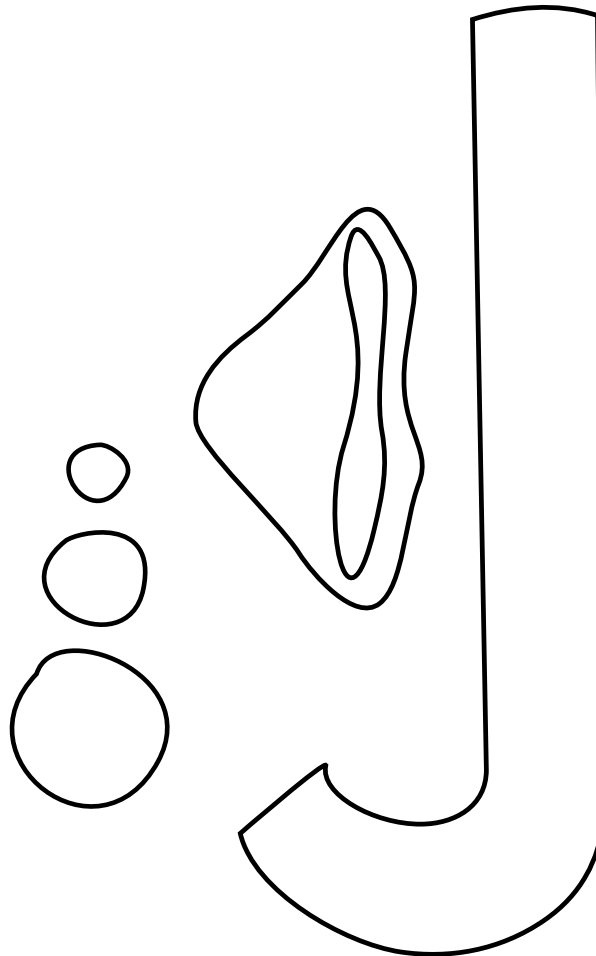


To make the "tentacles,"

(4) tape to the jellyfish.

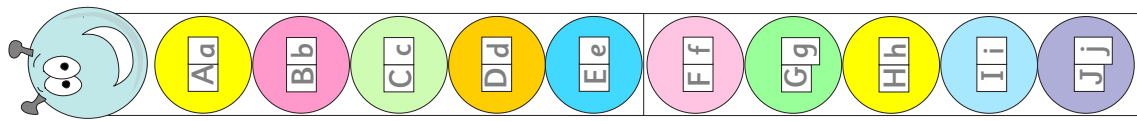

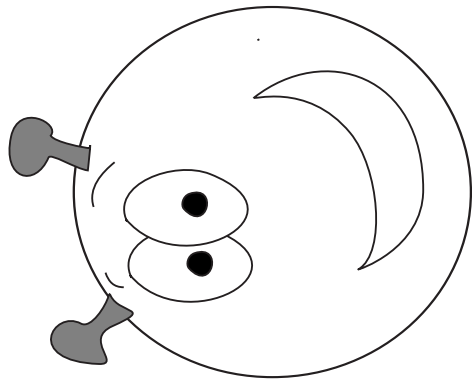
